#### Tour of the Museum

Join us on a guided tour of the Atkins-Johnson house and farm. This tour will include information not only on the property and its inhabitants, but also relevant political and geological history of the area.

#### Historic-Themed Activities

Includes Guided Historic-Themed Art Activity based on field trip focus, and various group games and activities that give a glimpse into "Ways of Life". Pick from a wide range of historic-themed activities related to your trip's focus; choose as many as desired.

#### Nature Walk & Scavenger Hunt

Nature walk along the Big Shoal Heritage Area Trail, ending at the historic Big Shoal Cemetery for an interactive scavenger hunt.

#### Beekeeping

Learn about Beekeeping and honey harvesting process at the two Big Shoal Heritage Area Hives.

#### Seed-to-Crop

Deep-Dive into planting, growing and harvesting process for all food on the property. Includes special activities at the Heirloom Garden. Students may harvest and take home a crop for additional \$2 fee each.

#### Themed Program of Choice

Specialty programming relating to study area of choice (i.e. Civil War themed add-ons, if that is your curriculum focus).
